

Golden Moment

Originally from Karabakh, Tofiq Bahramov became the first international football referee from the Soviet Union to achieve global fame. His crucial decision in favor of England's third goal during the 1966 FIFA World Cup Final at Wembley Stadium left a lasting impression on 98,000 spectators and became one of the most debated moments in world football history. After the match, he was personally awarded the copy of the "Golden Goddess" trophy and the "Golden Whistle" by Queen Elizabeth II.
